Dear ARSF Members and Prospective Members,

The ARSF Board of Directors is pleased to encourage you to apply for affiliation to ARSF for the 2012 membership year. Please first read through the revised ARSF Bylaws and make sure you understand the rules and regulations regarding the membership policies.

ARSF wants to involve all skippers in Asia, and encourage positive relations among all skippers, coaches, judges, and rope skipping organizations in Asia. We hope that everyone will share our interest in this goal and help contribute to rope skipping enhancement in a positive manner. In order to create a more unified rope skipping environment in Asia, ARSF suggests that only one rope skipping organization per Asian country applies for ARSF membership. In the case that there are multiple rope skipping organizations in a country, ARSF strongly encourages the leaders of each organization to communicate with each other and decide which organization best represents their country for membership in ARSF before applying. If an agreement cannot be made, then multiple organizations from the same country may apply for membership this year, but they will only receive provisional membership status if their applications are approved by the ARSF Board of Directors.

Please realize that if a country truly desires full membership and full participation rights in ARSF events (including the Asian Championships), then it is to their advantage and discretion to form one organization to represent their country. If they choose not to do so, then that is their decision and they will be limited by it. For the benefit of all skippers and people in Asia, let's work together peacefully to create a unified rope skipping Asia!

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation on this matter and look forward to another great year of rope skipping in Asia.

Requirements	Organizations that had full or provisional membership status in ARSF in 2011 (1 year or longer) and meet the following requirements: (1) The organization maintains positive relations with other rope skipping organizations, coaches, and skippers in their respective countries and in Asia, as well with ARSF. (2) The organization submits the required monthly rope skipping reports to ARSF and it is evident that they are actively promoting rope skipping in their country. (3) The organization has open membership and publicizes an open qualifying competition for the ARSF Asian Championships and FISAC-IRSF World Championships in which any skippers in their country may participate.	Rope skipping organizations in Asia that do not fulfill the requirements for full membership, or are from countries with multiple organizations that have applied for membership.
Deadline	<b>January 15, 2012</b> As of December 31, 2011 ARSF member organizations will lose their ARSF membership status and voting rights. Full membership will only be granted to eligible organizations which submit their application before January 15, 2012 and it is approved again by the ARSF Directors.	<b>Anytime</b> Submission of 2012 membership documents and payment of the membership fee may take place at any time in the year.
